**Be quick as closing 20 January**

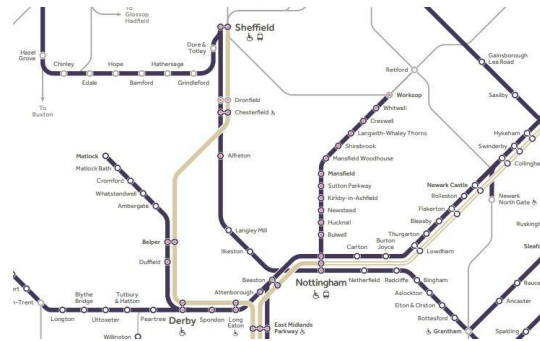
